The day is coming when suffering will cease and evil will be judged. "The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9

Point of Light #4

Our suffering will pale in comparison to what God has in store for His followers. "I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us." Romans 8:18 Point of Light #5

We decide whether to turn bitter or turn to God for peace and courage. "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." John 16:33

What is God's ultimate answer to the question of why is there suffering? It is not in words; it is the WORD! God's ultimate answer is not an explanation; it is the incarnation. Christ Jesus fully God and fully human, coming into our experience to live, die and rise again to new life!





TRINITY'S FIVE & DIME



It is refreshing and renewing to see God's handy work in our daily lives. Whether it is when he reveals himself to us through his word, or through something that we are privileged to see with our own eyes, either man made or by his design. These brief glimpses of his presence are both comforting and re-assuring that he is with us, and that peace it creates within us, is just a sample of his all-encompassing peace that we will receive when his Kingdom has finally come. This edition of The Five and Dime is centered on just that subject; and as we enter the Lenten and Easter season, it seemed to be the appropriate time to share this story.

It was a sight that I wished I would have had an extra 30 minutes to spare and be able to just sit and watch as God's canvas unfolded before me. But not having that extra time to spare, I went about my task, and went to back the car out of the garage. The garage is on the north side of our house, and the timber lies just to the north and east of the house. So, there is a fair number of trees on those two sides of the house, so if you're wanting to see anything other than trees, one must look up. As I backed the car out of the garage and turned it so that I was headed to go down the lane, I was able to look in the northeast direction. And it just so happens that in that direction, there is a break in the trees where more of the sky is visible.
