For many people, the pandemic redefined work, with more employees logging hours from a home office — or kitchen table. Boundaries between job and personal life blurred, as did any sense of being "off duty."

That means even work and worship interlock. As Rick Warren writes, "Work becomes worship when you dedicate it to God and perform it with an awareness of his presence."

## Two Trinity led Worship Services on Sunday, September 12th

At 9:00 a.m., Jerry Conroy will be leading a worship service at Carstens Farm, outside of Shelby, during their annual celebration. Each year, churches and pastors from around the area take turns leading Sunday worship there. Thank you to Jerry Conroy for volunteering to lead for us!

At 9:30 a.m., during Trinity's normal worship time, we will have Pastor George Black visiting and leading us in service. He helps with the Food for the Poor ministry and we will be learning more about that ministry during this time. His brief biography can be read below.

### **BIOGRAPHY FOR PASTOR GEORGE BLACK(NALC)**

Pastor George was born in Toledo, Ohio on February 4, 1948. He earned a B.A. degree in African History from the University of Colorado in 1972. He graduated from Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne, IN in 1977 with a Masters of Divinity degree. In 1994 he earned a Doctorate of Ministry degree from Concordia Theological Seminary. He has pastored six congregations during his 37 year career as a parish pastor. He taught as a visiting professor for four years in the Doctor of Ministry program at Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne. Pastor George also served twelve years on the LCMS Foundation Board of Directors, of which the last eight he served as its chairman. A dozen times in the past twenty years he was served as a short term theological missionary in Ghana, West Africa. In May of 2014 he retired from the parish ministry. In June of 2014 Pastor George began preaching part time for Food for the Poor. In November of 2016 he moved to Foresthill, CA, a mountain community in Northern California. He serves as a half time pastor for a small North American Lutheran Church congregation, Our Savior Lutheran Church, in Auburn, CA, fifteen miles below his home. In March of 2020, Pastor George became a pastoral member of the North American Lutheran Church (NALC). He and his wife, Julie K. nee Aarthun celebrated their 52<sup>st</sup> wedding anniversary on 2-28-2021. God has blessed them with three children and two grandchildren.
